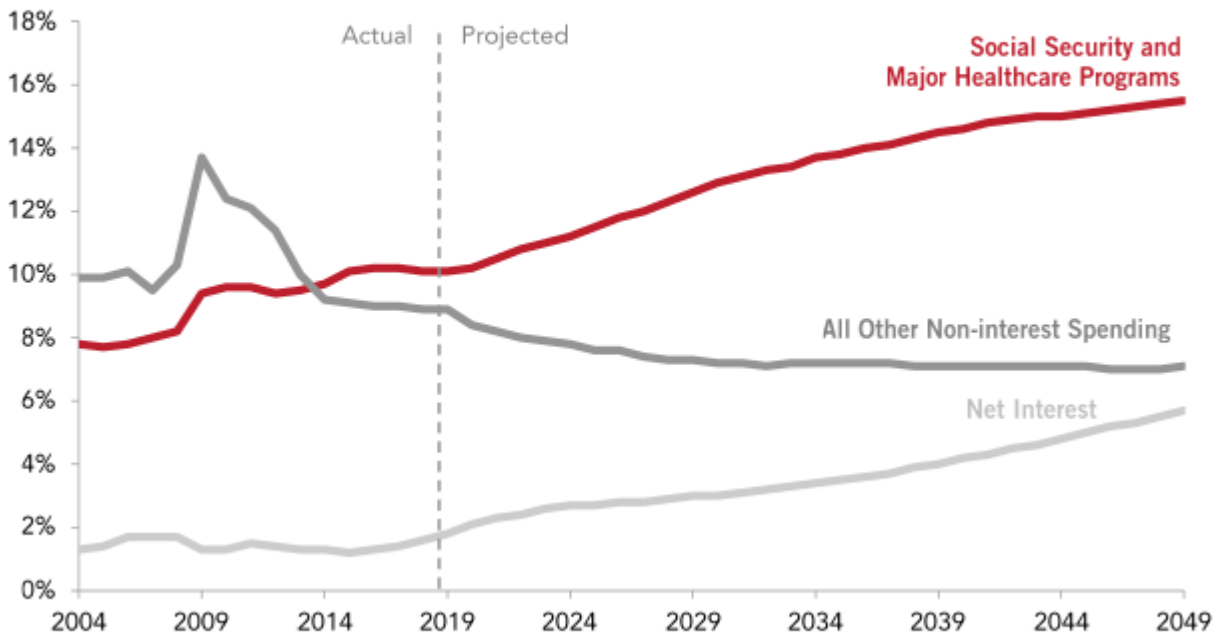


Projected Spending, Social Security and Health Programs
