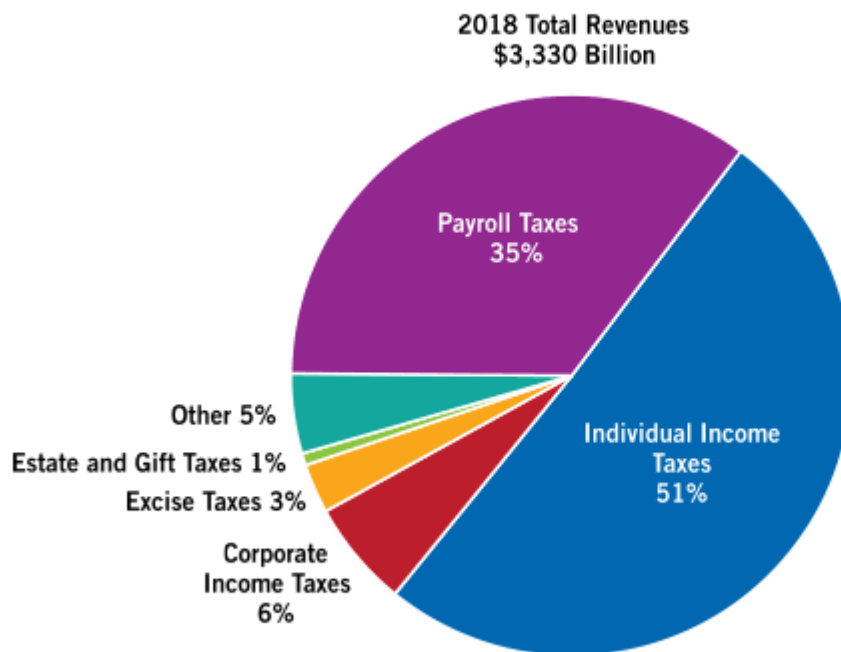


Where taxes came from in 2018
