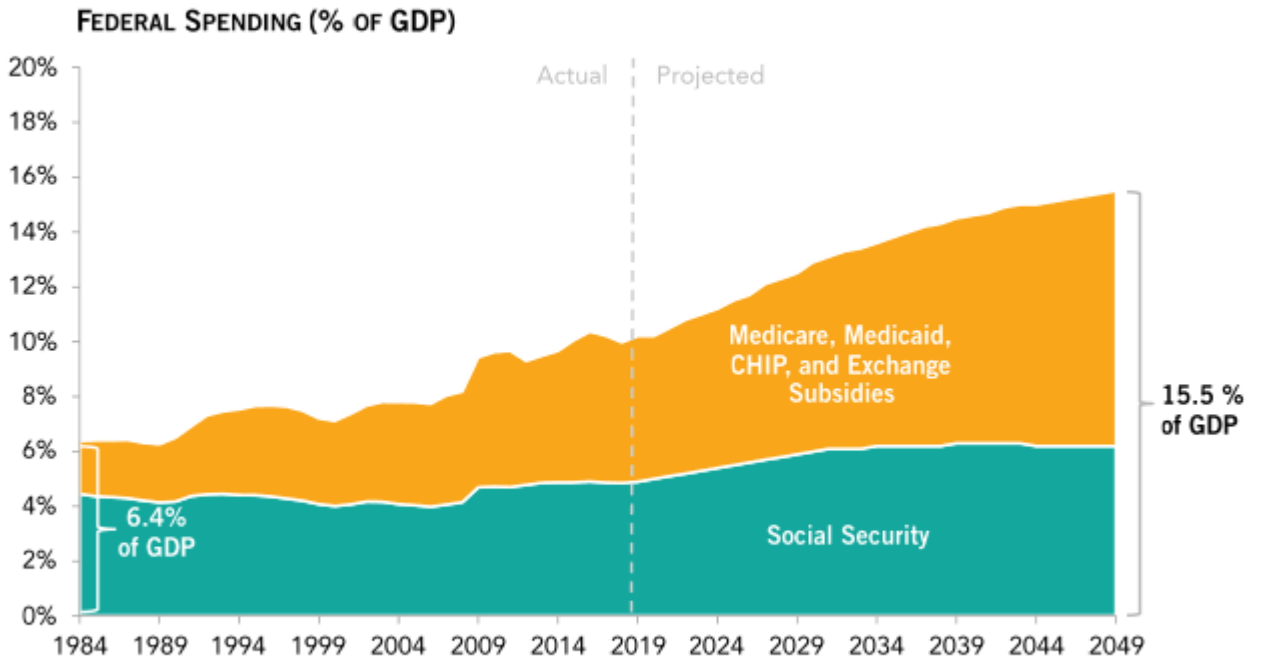


The Growth of Entitlement Programs
