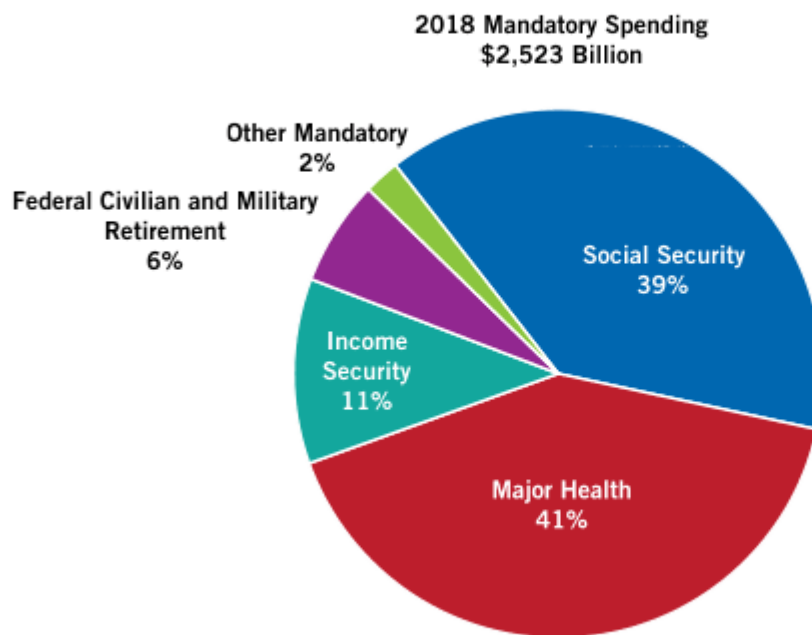


# Mandatory Spending Composition
