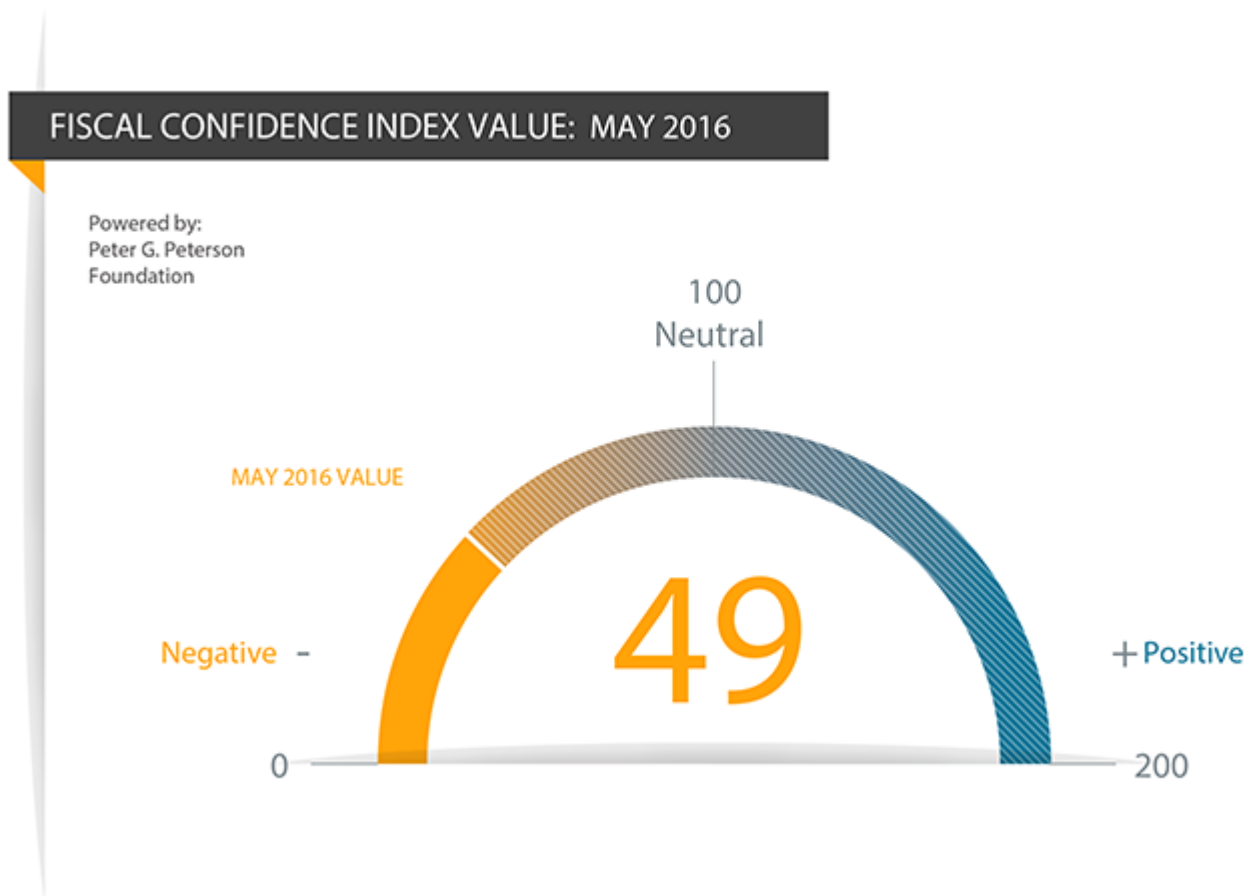


Fiscal Confidence Index: May 2016 Results



Topline survey results from the Fiscal Confidence Index for **May 2016**. The FCI value for May is 49.

The Peter G. Peterson Foundation commissioned the poll by the Global Strategy Group and North Star Opinion Research to survey public opinion on the national debt. The nationwide poll included 1,004 U.S. registered voters, surveyed by telephone between May 23 and May 26, 2016. The poll has a margin of error of +/- 3.1%. The poll examined voters' opinions on the national debt, political leadership, and America's fiscal and economic health.

The Fiscal Confidence Index value is derived from six questions in three categories: Concern, Priority, and Expectations. The April 2016 scores are: Concern (37), Priority (21), Expectations (88).
