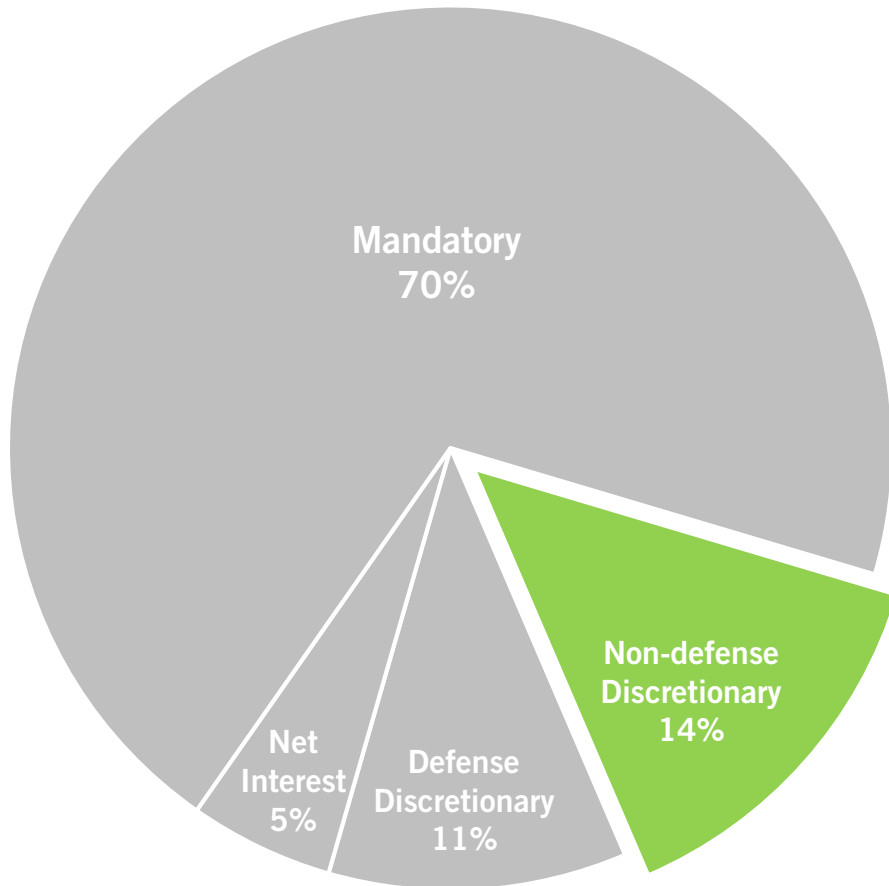
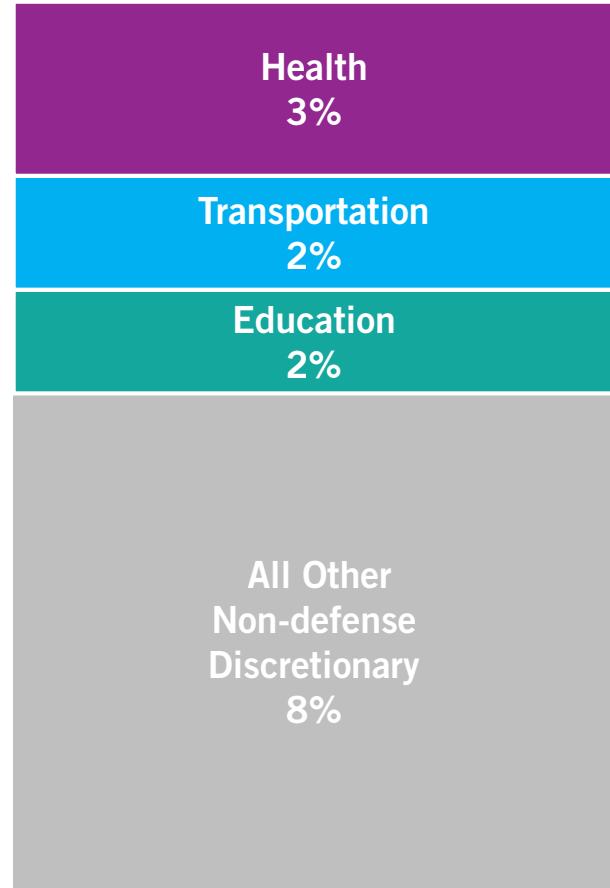


Non-defense discretionary programs include spending for investments
