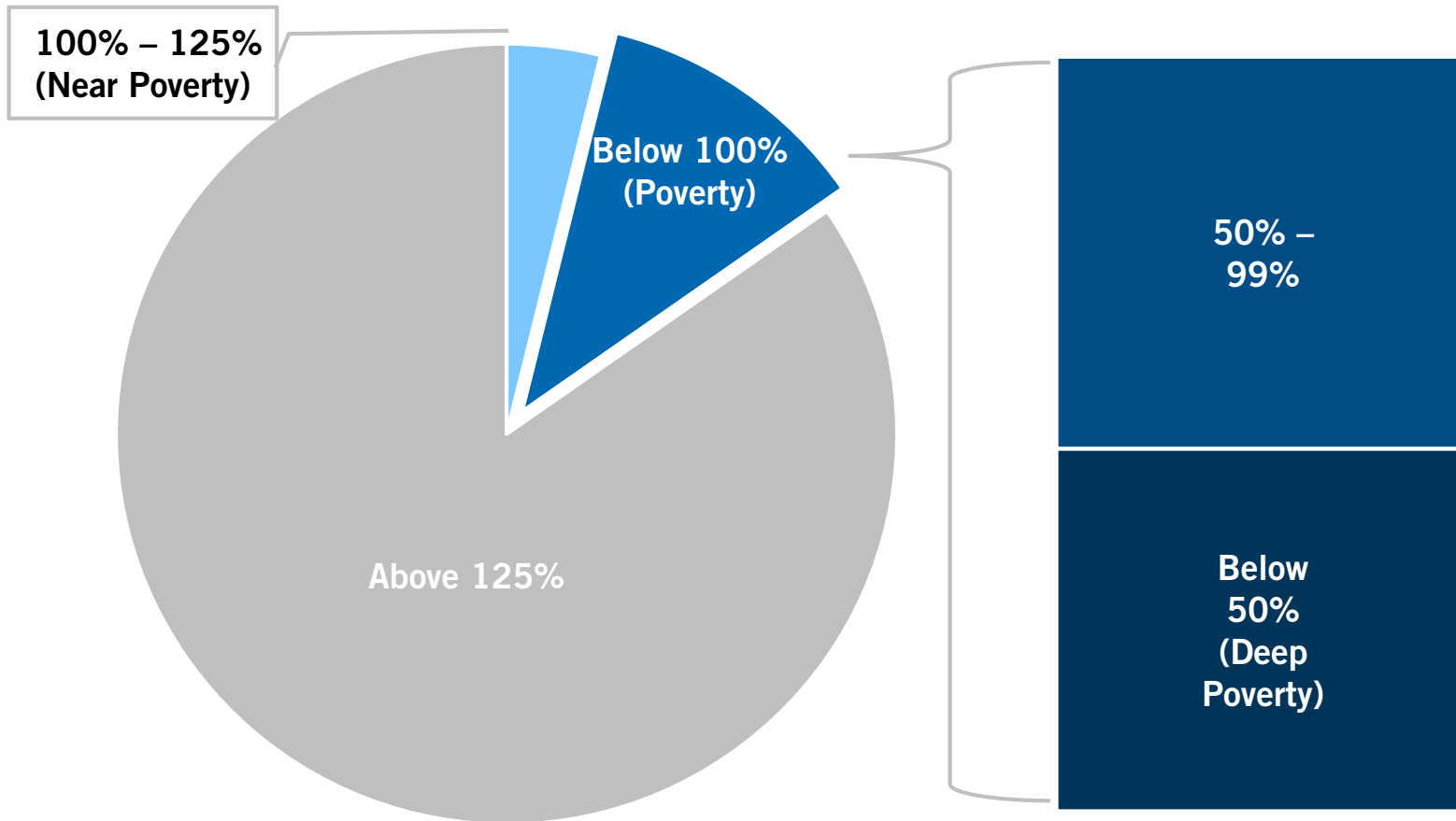


Over 11 percent of the population lives in poverty, and nearly half of those in poverty live in deep poverty
