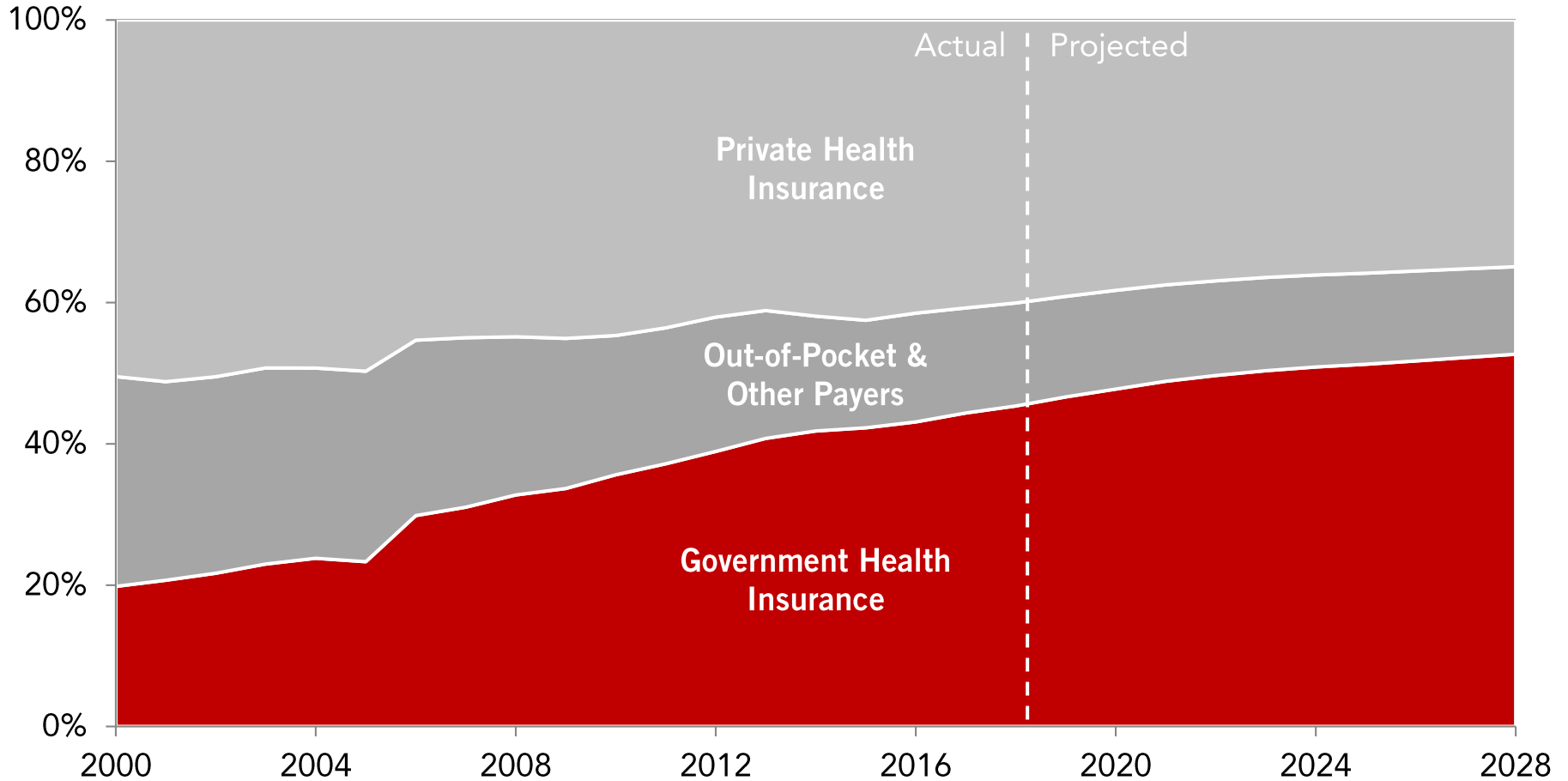


Government health insurance is paying for a larger share of prescription drug expenditures

NOTES: Government health insurance programs include Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, and other federal healthcare. CMS defines "out-of-pocket spending" to include direct spending by consumers for all healthcare goods and services not covered by insurance, including coinsurance and deductibles. Premiums paid by individuals for private health insurance are counted as part of private health insurance.
