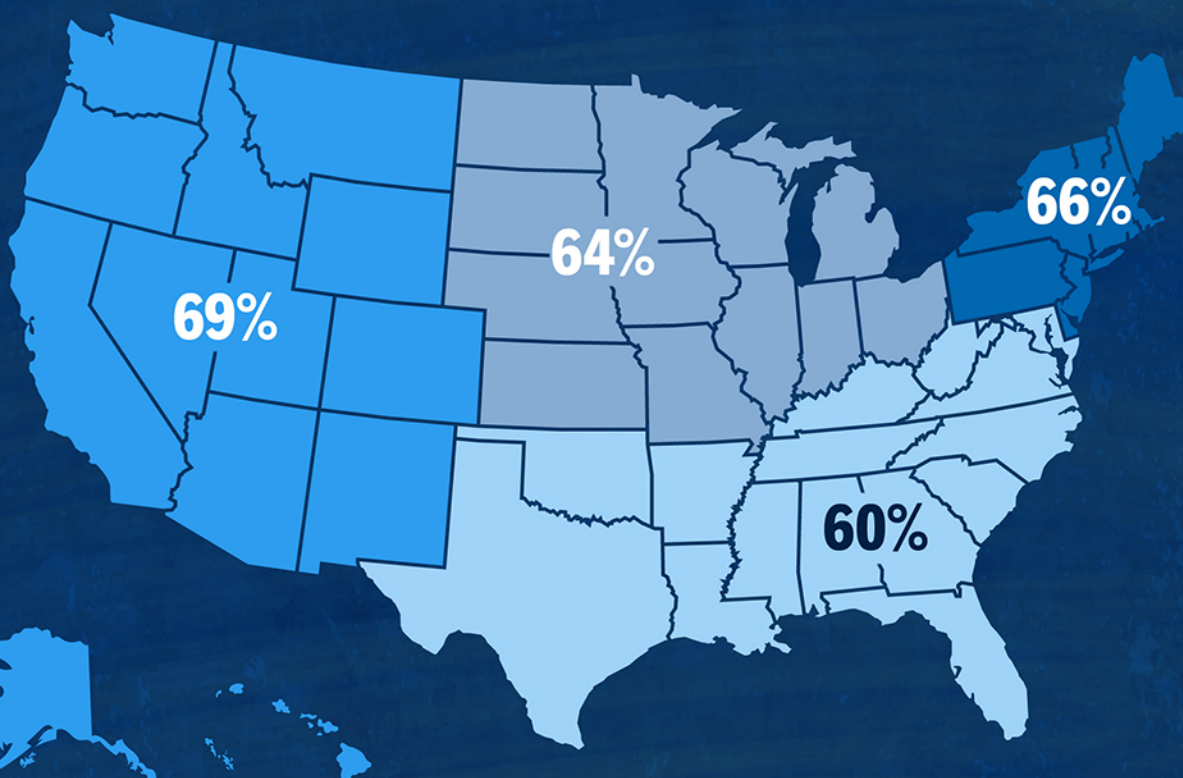


# SIX IN 10 VOTERS *OPPOSE* REOPENING K-12 SCHOOLS *IN THEIR STATES*

## The vast majority of voters

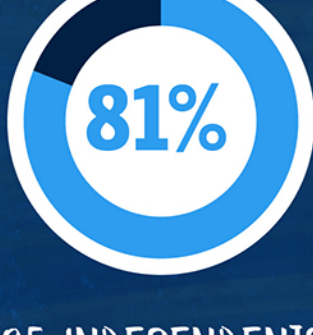
(81% nationwide) agree on the

the health of students, teachers, and parents over the economy, including:



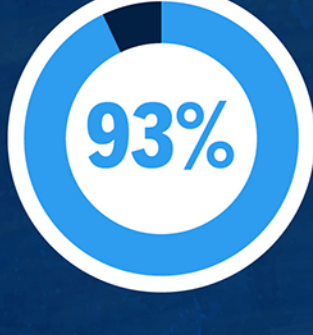

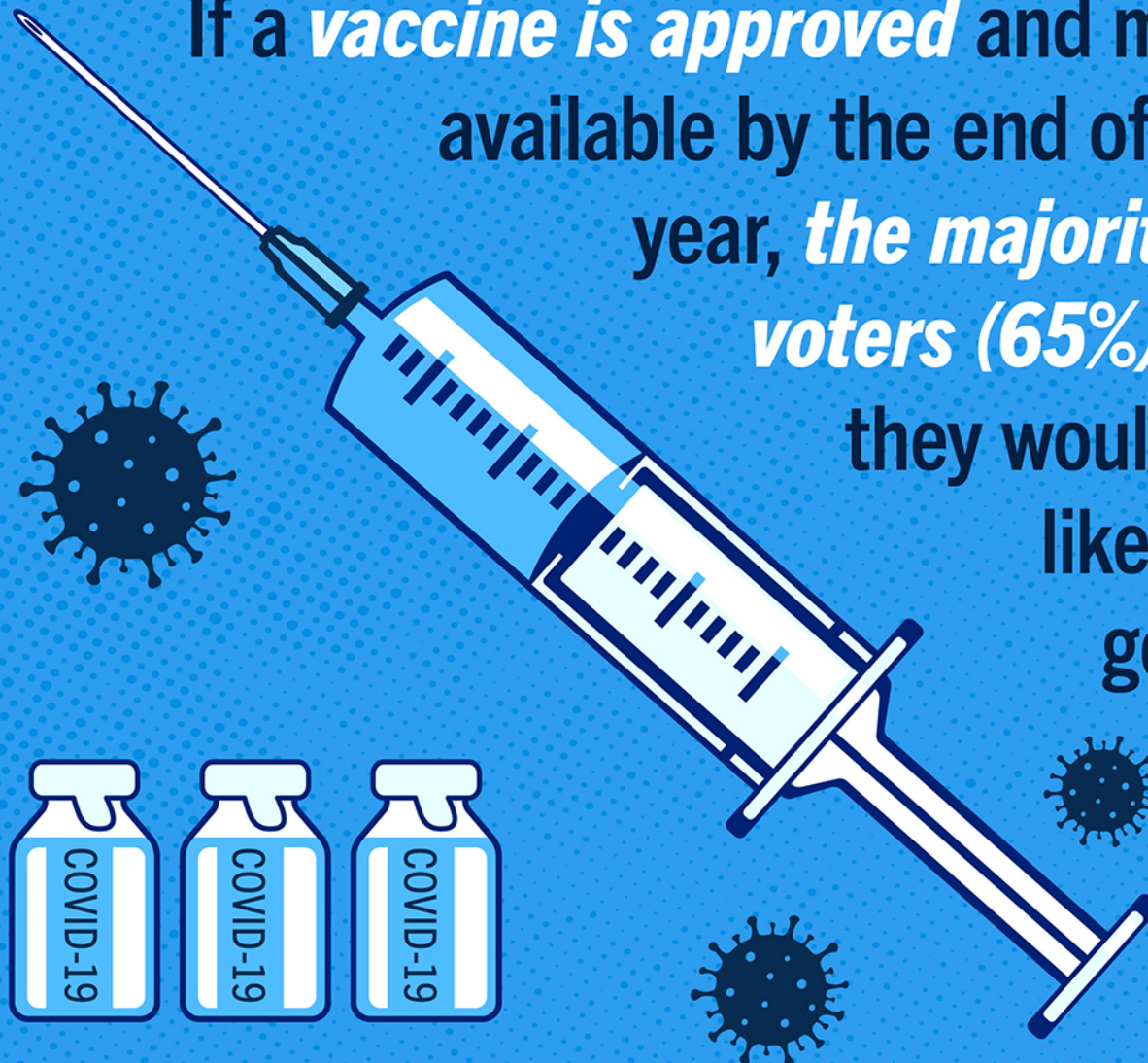

If a ***vaccine is approved*** and made available by the end of this year, ***the majority of voters (65%)*** say they would be likely to get it.



**Two-thirds (66%)** believe it will take the U.S. economy ***more than a year*** to fully recover.

**65% of voters** believe restrictions on non-essential businesses and social distancing requirements should be lifted ***in three months or longer.***
