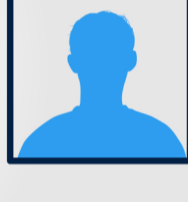
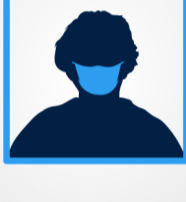
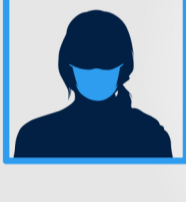

TWO-THIRDS SAY THE CORONAVIRUS HAS IMPACTED PERSONAL OR BUSINESS DECISIONS,



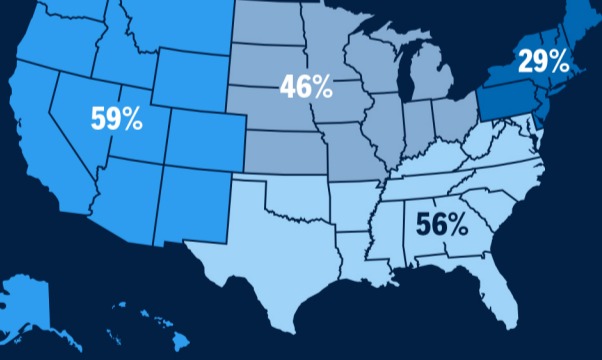

Half of voters (49%) say the outbreak will worsen in their communities,



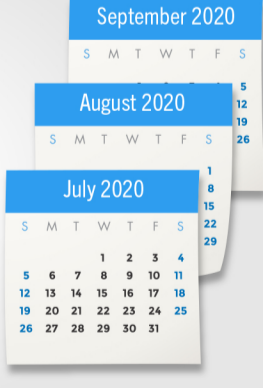
