**Most Americans (56%) say it will take *a year or longer* to fully recover from the pandemic's impact,**

**while 44% expect recovery to *happen within a year.***

**SEVEN IN 10 AMERICANS (74%) REPORTED THAT THE OUTBREAK HAS IMPACTED THEIR PERSONAL OR BUSINESS DECISIONS**



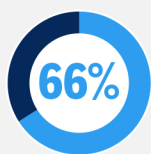

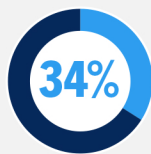
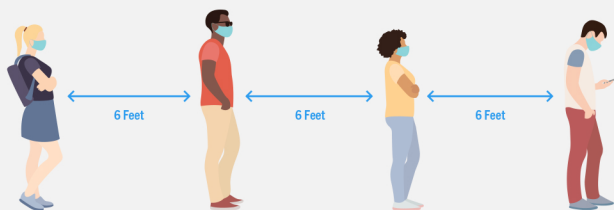
