



The majority of Democrats and Republicans believe corporations and higher earners *should pay more taxes*


Percentage of voters who support:

	Nationwide	Democrat	Independent	Republican
Closing tax loopholes	89%	92%	87%	86%
Raising the corporate income tax rate	71%	87%	79%	51%
Raising taxes on higher-income earners	80%	94%	84%	63%
Increasing IRS enforcement to crack down on tax evasion	86%	88%	83%	84%



94% want the *next president to pay for spending priorities* so that they *don't increase the deficit*.

With less than 2 weeks to go, *6 in 10 voters do not expect to vote in person* on Election Day.

Without additional federal relief, voters say that they have *fallen short paying for* :

Food and Groceries	22%	20%	31%	23%
Credit Card	23%	20%	44%	25%
Rent or Mortgage	18%	17%	25%	22%
Vehicle	24%	23%	38%	22%
Student Loan	45%	42%	61%	41%



Despite the economic impact, *65% of voters want restrictions on non-essential businesses and social distancing requirements to stay for at least three more months.*
